### The Cret Building

Inside the 1917 historic Cret Building, interior renovations and reconstructions are substantially completed. This includes new mechanical and electrical systems, carpeting, wall finishes, lighting fixtures, glass replacements, and restoration of the beautiful ceiling artwork.

## The Atrium

The Atrium will serve as the hub of the Central Library as well as a central gathering place. The Information and Circulation Desks, Self-Check stations, Holds pick-up, Automated Catalogues, Exhibition Area, and Café will all be located here. From the Atrium, patrons will be able to access The Learning Curve @ Central, the historic Cret building, the East Garden, and the new Tower Building.

Circulation and Information desks are being installed, as well as wall panels. The installation of the glass wall between the Atrium and Tower has been completed, and the engraving of additional authors' names in limestone on the south side of the Atrium has been completed.
